This course is designed and structured to provide training in the safe use of abrasive wheels and meets with the requirements of the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations (PUWER 98) and covers the following subjects:

- The Need to Train and Statutory Requirements
- Characteristics of an Abrasive Wheel and the Types
- Marking of Abrasive Wheels
- Speed
- Hazards and Precautions to be Taken
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Storage and Handling of Abrasive Wheels
- Inspection and Methods of Testing for Damage
- Abrasive Wheel Machine Components
- Guarding
- Dressing & Truing
- Specific Mounting Procedures

The course will last ½ day and on completion of the course learners will receive a Building Futures East certificate of attendance, an individual training record (to provide proof of training) and a comprehensive set of course notes for each trainee.
